Storage

- Store in cool, well ventilated area.
- Keep container tightly closed.

Health & Safety

- Contains Sodium Hypochlorite.
- Approved HSE BIOCIDAL LICENCE NUMBER 9853.
- Protect any surface or area not being treated.
- Never mix or add any other cleaners or acid to the product.
- Keep locked up and away from children.
- Keep away from plants.
- Keep away animals and pets until cleaning process is complete and surface is dry.

- Will bleach most fabrics.
