- Check all components prior to assembly
- This product should be assembled by no less than two people.
- Drill pilot holes for screws to avoid splitting and cracking the timber.

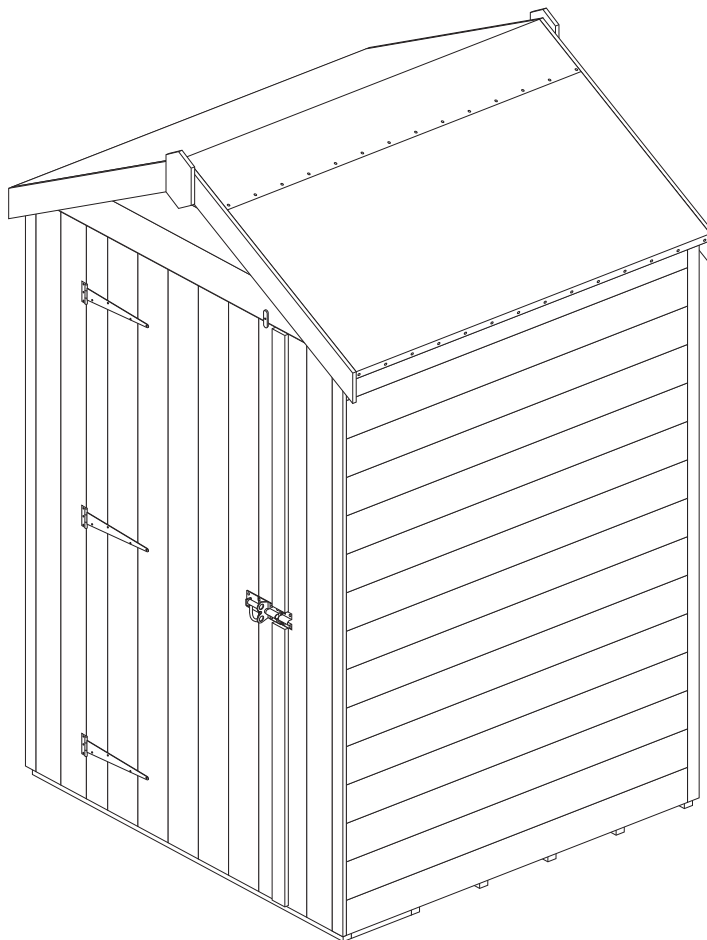


Recommended tools for assembly

- Step ladder

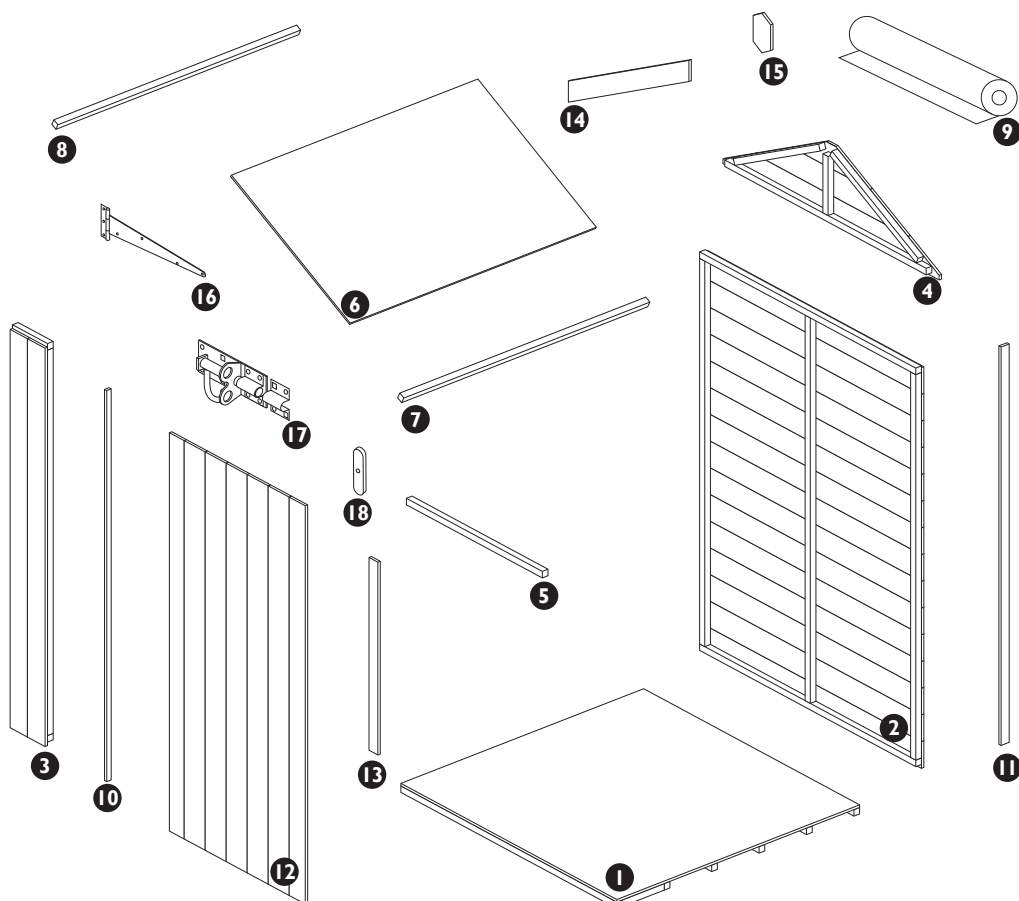
Biocidal Products Regulation EU 528/2012

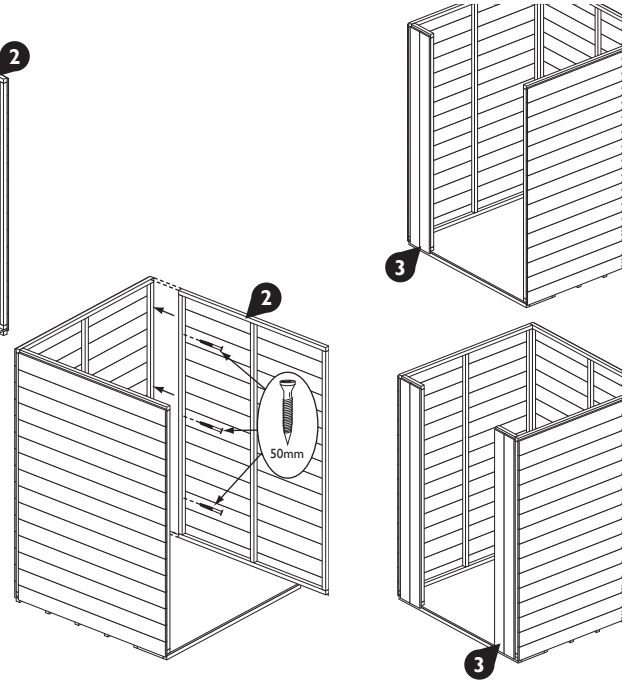
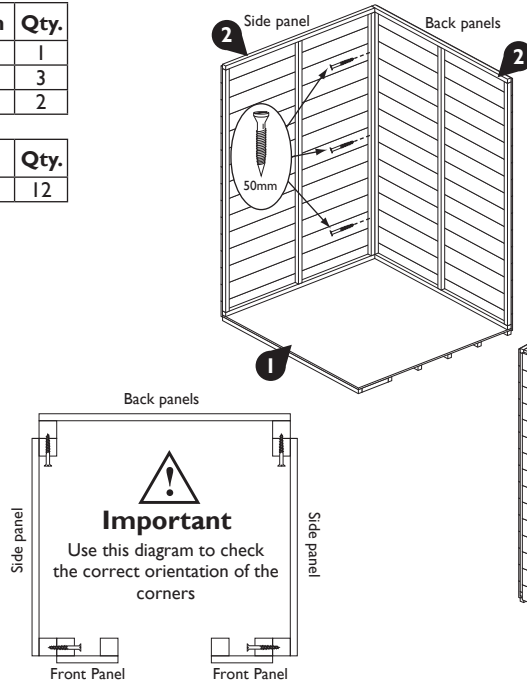
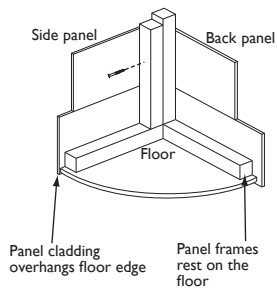
Prepare a firm level area that is slightly larger than the floor, for the shed to sit. To protect the floor and validate the anti-rot guarantee, adequate provision must be made to ensure ground contact is avoided. The building must not be allowed to sit in pooled water during wet conditions and air must be able to circulate underneath the building. Recommended base options include either:

- Concrete pad
- Slabs
- Decking
- 50x50mm pressure treated timber bearers (minimum requirement)

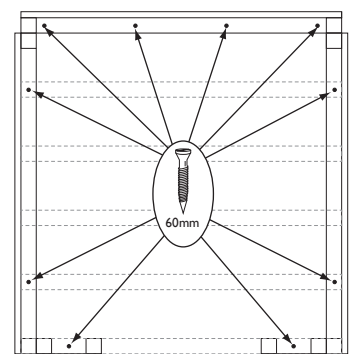
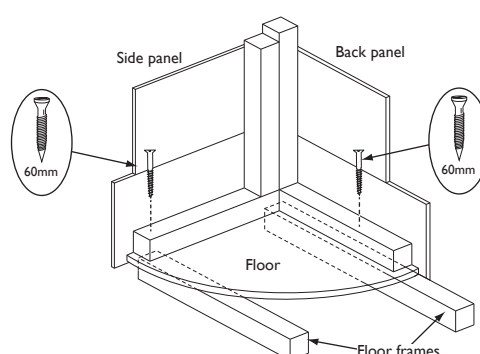
4. Secure Walls to Floor

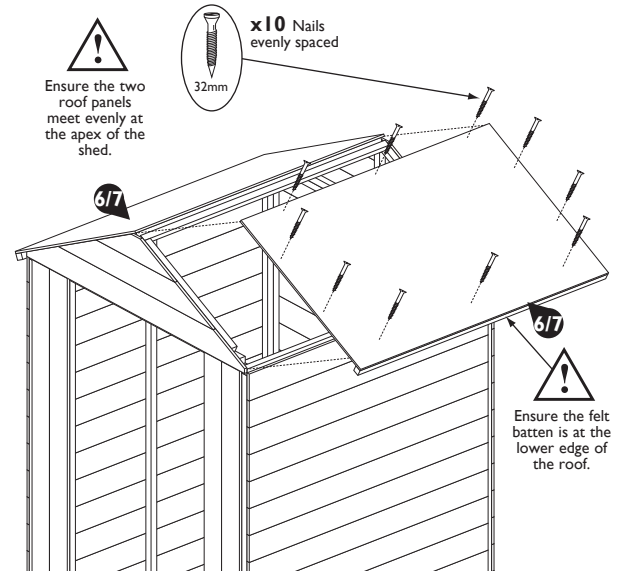
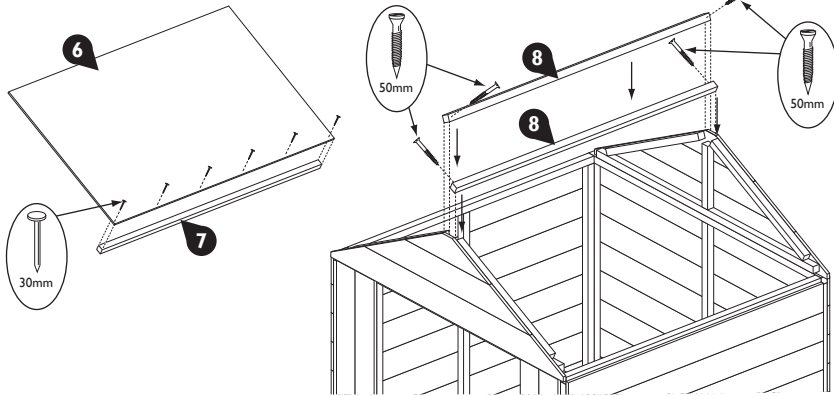
When screwing the walls to the floor. Always ensure the screws are aligned so that the screw goes through the wall panel frame and floor and into the floor frame.

Timber Information.

As timber is a natural material, there are certain weather conditions that may affect the materials properties. In times of excessive dry spells the material may lose some of its internal moisture causing a certain degree of shrinkage on a panel and in periods of excessive rain there will be a certain amount of swelling throughout the wooden panels. This process can not be avoided. If you have problems with certain boards shrinking in dry spells try to decrease the amount of direct sunlight on the building or the amount of air passing over the building.
