





Top Fire Protection – it does not go on fire easily, plus does not emit hazardous gazes when it burns





Top fire protection.

The natural fibres of the sheep wool have a self-combustion temperature of 560 – 600°C. This is around twice as high as that of wood (270°C). It also melts away from a heat source without dripping.
